Michael Earley, OD, PhD

Dr. Earley is Assistant Dean for Clinic Services, Clinic Chief of Binocular Vision and Pediatric Services, and Professor of Clinical Optometry at The Ohio State University College of Optometry. He also directs the pediatric fellowship program. In clinic, he primarily works with children with special needs and patients following traumatic brain injury. He teaches coursework in neuroanatomy, histology, ocular anatomy and binocular vision and graduate coursework in visual processing.

Dr. Earley has received OSU's highest teaching award, the Alumni Award for Distinguished Teaching, and was inducted into the Academy of Teaching. He is involved in clinical research and participates in multicentered clinical research projects. He has published articles in numerous journals and lectures nationally on neuroanatomy and its clinical implications.



Karla Zadnik, OD, PhD

Dr. Zadnik is Associate Dean of The Ohio State University College of Optometry where she also serves as the Glenn A. Fry Professor in Optometry and Physiological Optics. She conducts patient-based research in myopia and keratoconus and has received federal funding for this work since 1991. She is also Chair of the University's Biomedical Sciences Institutional Review Board and IRB Policy Committee.

Dr. Zadnik is recipient of the Dr. Donald R. Korb Award for Excellence from the American Optometric Association; the James M. Siddens Award for Faculty Advising from The Ohio State University; and the Galileo Award for Research Excellence in Children's Vision and Learning from the American Foundation for Vision Awareness.

Dr. Zadnik serves as president of the American Academy of Optometry.
